Recycle: Buy gently used items that are new to you!

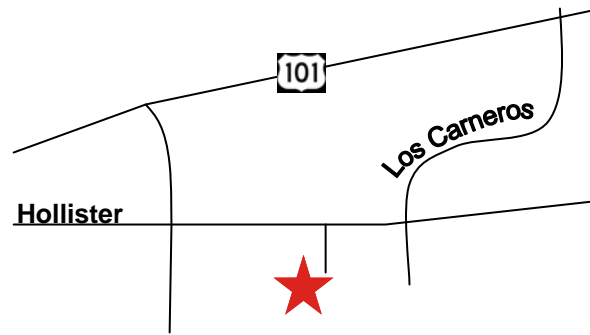


ReStore: Everyone can shop here. We accept cash, credit cards or checks. Prices are 30%-80% below normal retail prices.

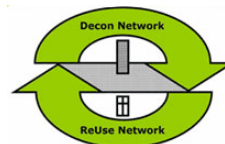
